### **Code Enforcement**

John Lands presented his monthly report: He issued two demolition permits and received 28 phone calls in October, and two electrical permits issued in September.

#### **Emergency Management**

Roger Dunfee is appointed interim director of EM for the City of Grayson effective November 1st. EM director reported an accumulation of supplies for the shelter. They have moved the shelter supplies into the old Health Dept. on US 60. Smoke in the air has been caused by fires in neighboring counties. Rain is expected, and this may clear the air.

### **Street Department**

Chris reported they are good. No requests were made. The Mayor commented on the flags and mentioned the compliments the city has received.

### **Police Report**

Monthly Activity Report was presented. No request at this time.

Mayor Steele mentioned that they will be looking at the fleet and will need to start replacing vehicles soon and may look at a different brand.

## **Alcohol Department**

Willis Johnson presented his monthly report. Shoney's is one step closer in getting a KY Alcohol License pending an upcoming inspection. He presented an idea of creating a Blood/Alcohol Chart to help determine the percentage of alcohol in the blood stream based on weight and how many drinks you have consumed and posting in businesses selling alcohol in the city. Mayor Steele said approval of the Council was not needed and he can go ahead with it.
